## 1. Changes with respect to the DoA (Description of the Action)

## 2. Dissemination and uptake

The meeting was intended for the PARIS consortium, to kick off the project and introduce it to the consortium and interested scientists. An overview is available on the project website, minutes have been provided to the participants. Presentations are available for the consortium on the ICOS Carbon Portal.

## 3. Summary

The meeting, held 17 – 19<sup>th</sup> of January 2023 in Utrecht, NL, was the joint kick-off of the project after the official start on 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2023. The meeting was organised by the UU in collaboration with UNIVBRIS.

The aim was to introduce the consortium (beneficiaries and partner organisations), inform about the administrative requirements and discuss short-, medium- and long-term research requirements based on the Grant Agreement. The agenda included a general overview of the expectations of the EU as funding agency, represented by the project officer), and in depths discussions about the scientific and preparatory work needed per work package, required networking and interactions between the groups. The WP leaders met in advance of the kick-off meeting to discuss the overarching organisation of work packages in the project including reporting towards the coordinator. During the meeting, each WP leader introduced her/his work package in an overview presentation. These presentations are available via the ICOS Carbon Portal, which will be the official data storage of PARIS.

The implementation of tasks for the upcoming months has been discussed per WP, either plenary or in parallel sessions with the respective consortium members involved. Emphasis was laid on data management and the organisation of inventory team engagement as two of the central topics within PARIS. Furthermore, a first step was made in collaboration with the related EU projects EYE-CLIMA and AVENGERS, by invited presentations of the coordinators EYE-CLIMA and AVENGERS.

In total 50 participants joint the PARIS kick off meeting, in person and online (MS Teams). All beneficiaries and partner organisations were represented, besides this several guest from EYE-CLIMA and AVENGERS were welcomed.

Organised as a combined networking activity / meeting dinner, the participants joint a vegan/vegetarian cooking workshop.
